- Richmond Fairgrounds is located in the village of Richmond, which is part of the Greater Ottawa. Richmond is famous for its bakery. It also has a quilt shop at walking distance from the fairgrounds.
- The Fairgrounds can accommodate over 100 coaches and is reserved for our group only. We will have a lot of room to park with space between each coach.
- 15 amps service and water will be available for each coach. There is a dump station on site. There will not be any restrictions for the use of generators if required.
- WiFi is currently not available on site, but the Fairgrounds is negotiating to have it installed. No promises yet, but we might have it for our rally.
- We have arranged for an early arrival on the Monday before the beginning of the Rally. We will offer information for optional self-guided activities (things to see / places to go) for Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday for those arriving early and interested in sightseeing on their own.
- If you want to arrive earlier than Monday June 13 (or leave later than Sunday June 19), contact your host for special arrangements.
